

The Three Kinds of Note-making

The questions answered by inspectional reading are:

1. What kind of book is it?
2. What is it about as a whole?
3. What is the structural order of the work whereby general subject matter?

The notes at this level of reading are, therefore, not structural but conceptual. They concern the author's concepts, and also your own as they have been deepened or broadened by your reading of the book.
